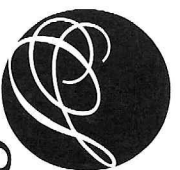

History

Dr. Lorraine Missling, UW-Eau Claire professor emerita of business education and administrative management was very involved in Delta Kappa Gamma Society on the chapter and state level.



She served as president of the state and was the recipient of the Delta Kappa Gamma International Scholarship. It was her gift through a bequest to Sigma State which provided the funding to support the creation of the foundation.

In her report to the state at the convention on April 27, 1991, Dr. Missling stated, "Our intent is to reach every member in the entire state of Wisconsin-every member is important and every member can contribute a great deal!"

In 1999, The Foundation was officially established as a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization.
