Granada is a hardy, hybrid tea rose producing high-centered, double, extremely fragrant, blended rose-pink, red, and lemon-yellow flowers with leathery, dark green leaves.



## *American Beauty*

The American Beauty is exceptionally beautiful and fragrant. The rose bush produces round shaped buds that open into large, pink-carmine colored rose flowers. The roses have blooms that are formed by 50 rose petals.



## *Chrysler Imperial*

This rose was one of the first roses to be involved in the promotional marketing of a consumer product, the Chrysler Imperial car. The buds are elegantly tapered and open into high-centered flowers up to 5 inches across, with a rich, deep, velvety red color. The strongly scented flowers start blooming in late spring and repeat throughout the summer. The foliage is semi-glossy and deep green with thorny canes.



## *Lorraine's Mr. Lincoln*

Mr. Lincoln was Lorraine Missling's favorite rose. It has won more awards than any other red hybrid tea, including selection as an All-American rose. One of the all-time classic red roses, it is grown virtually everywhere. The velvety, deep red flowers have perfect form, a strong fragrance, and top long stems that are perfect for the vase.



## *Heritage*

The Heritage rose has plump buds that open into large and beautifully cupped flowers in the style of an Old Garden Rose. The flowers come in a variety of pink shades, from the palest blush to warm rose pink deep in the center of the blooms. The fragrance is a lovely citrus-lemon scent. The foliage is semi-glossy and dark green.



## *Symphony*

Symphony is a medium yellow rose. The double blooms appear mostly in clusters with an occasional single bloom. Symphony has a light pleasant fragrance. It grows as a moderately short shrub.



## *Tiffany*

Tiffany is one of the older Hybrid Teas, but is considered one of the all-time best. Unlike so many of its clan, it has a strong, sweet fragrance. The medium pink blooms with the golden yellow centers open slowly, holding that classic hybrid tea form for a long time before opening fully. Blooms have about 20 petals, and open fully to display stamens.
