

**Bylaws of Wisconsin State Organization
The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International
Revised April 2021**

**Article IV
Finances**

Section 1. Annual Dues

57 A. The annual state dues shall be determined by a two-thirds vote of the members of the
58 state Executive Board at the convention in odd-numbered years.

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60 Section 2. Payment of Dues and Fees

61 A. The membership year is July 1-June 30. A member shall pay annual dues and fees no
62 later than June 30 for the following fiscal year.

~~63 B. An induction fee of \$10 shall be required of all members except honorary members.~~

64 C. A scholarship fee of \$1 shall be paid annually by each active and reserve member.

65 D. Members inducted or reinstated between July 1 and December 31 shall pay induction
66 fees, dues, and scholarship fees for the current year. Members reinstated on or after
67 January 1 shall pay one-half the international membership dues. Chapter and state
68 organization dues may be pro-rated as the chapter/state organization determines.

69 E. The state portion of the dues and fees shall be sent to the state treasurer.

70 F. The international portion of the dues and fees shall be sent between July 1 and
71 September 30.

72 G. A member who fails to complete payment of international dues shall be dropped as of
73 October 1.

74 H. The inducting unit of Wisconsin State Organization shall pay a lifetime fee in the
75 amount of \$49.50 for each honorary member at the time of induction.

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77 Section 3. Financial Controls

78 A. The state Finance Committee shall submit a proposed operating budget (Available
79 Fund) annually to the state Executive Board. Operating budget approval shall require a
80 two-thirds majority vote of the state Executive Board.

81 B. The state Finance Committee chair shall approve the state president's expense
82 vouchers with a signature.

83 C. The state president shall sign all other expense vouchers before the state treasurer
84 makes payment.

85 D. The audit/review shall be completed on or before August 15 by a state Financial Review
86 Committee appointed by the state president.

87 E. The report of the annual audit/review shall be submitted to the state Executive Board
88 at the next state convention or state conference.

89 F. Chapter information packets not picked up at the state convention or the state
90 conference will be mailed to the chapters, and the chapters will be billed for postage.
