

Grant History and Purpose

In 1976, three Sigma State members, Louise Linn, Mini Benson, and Helen Streng, perceived a need that existed for many of our members. They realized that "Creative women who have developed instructional materials have difficulty in finding a publisher to market their materials."

Additionally, the inclusion of peerpublished articles provides an avenue to highlight and share members' expertise on current educational topics.

Publication support is needed because:

- Some publishing companies exploit people with good ideas by hiring them as "consultants." Good ideas make millions for the company: the originator receives only a small salary.
- Materials produced by teachers are usually tested in classrooms and have been proven successful.
- Materials should be shared with others who have similar needs.
- Good ideas have been copied without benefit to the originator.
- Teachers may need the expertise of a publication specialist and/or illustrator to make materials appealing and succinct.

GAEP Fund

The 1980 State Convention gave its approval to implement GAEP. At the 1988 State Convention, a recommendation was made and passed to financially support GAEP. Presently, a determined financial base remains in the fund and awards are given from the accrued interest.

Books and electronic media for children and adults and supplementary teaching aids have become a reality through this fund. Grants to members range from \$500 to \$1000. Additional grants for peer-reviewed journal articles are \$25 per page with a minimum length of two pages.



Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- Have been a member of this honor society for two calendar years prior to submitting an application.
- Have demonstrated active involvement at the chapter and/or state level.
- Demonstrated life-long learning

 professional and community involvement.

Grant Criteria

- Depth of plan
- Educational goals
- Intended audience
- Project cost
- All publications must identify Sigma State Wisconsin as a financial contributor within the project or author's biography.
- Materials for books, media, and kits must be sufficiently developed so that publication can be realized within a threeyear period.
- Peer-reviewed journal articles must have been published.
- Applications are due February 1st of each calendar year.
